

Minimum Fire Safe Regulations - "Substandard" Roads Board of Forestry and Fire Protection

- Proposed changes would impact rebuilding and new building on roads that were considered to be "substandard" including dead end or one-way roads, any road less than 14 feet wide, having less than 13 feet of clearance or a slope steeper than 20%.
- County will be writing a letter.

Transparency Rules for Fire Insurance

California Department of Insurance

- New rules will give homeowners and businesses open access to their properties' wildfire risk scores including what actions they can take that will directly impact these scores.
- Public pre-notice workshops on March 30 on the wildfire risk score regulations, and on April 6 on the complete rate filing regulations





Cell Tower Battery Backups CPUC

- Wireless providers are required to implement a 72-hour backup power solution to maintain minimum service coverage to "Tier 2 and Tier 3 High Fire Threat Districts" during disasters or commercial grid outages.
- Gas generators may be used as a primary backup source but providers must continue to explore other renewable options for the power supplies.
- The deadline for implementation is 7-20-21.

Chipping Program

Resource Conservation District

- Due to funding cuts, Santa Clara Fire Safe council is not able to provide wood chipping services for any of the residents in Santa Cruz County.
- Santa Cruz Resource Conservation District will be offering services starting in June.
- Prioritizing neighborhoods with 8 or more participants.
- Limit of \$250/property (collectively)
- Angie Gruys is coordinating the chipping program and will be doing direct outreach once everything has been finalized. agruys@rcdsantacruz.org
- GreenWaste customers who have service do have the option of calling GreenWaste and scheduling up to 4 extra pickups: santacruzcs@greenwaste.com





Wild Fire ALERT Cameras

County of Santa Cruz, County Fire

- We are coordinating with County fire to install 2-4 additional wild fire alert cameras this year.
- Negotiating data sharing agreement.





FAA Flight Path IssueCounty of Santa Cruz, County Fire

- FAA presented updated plan to Congressman Panetta and Congresswoman Eshoo. The plan was not in line with the select committee recommendations.
