

**Administrative Correction Sideletter**

**9.5 Holidays**

To correct the unintended consequences of the changes made during the last round of negotiations, the parties agree to modify Article 9.5 (previously number Article 10.5) as follows:


The following language will be restored to Article 9.5:


If January 1, March 31, June 19, July 4, November 11 or December 25 falls upon a Sunday, the Monday following is a Santa Cruz County holiday; and if any of said dates falls upon a Saturday, the preceding Friday is a Santa Cruz County holiday. Should December 25 fall on a Saturday, the preceding Friday is a Santa Cruz County holiday and December 24 will be treated as a Santa Cruz County holiday on the preceding Thursday. Should December 25 fall on a Sunday or Monday, December 24 will be treated as a Santa Cruz County holiday on the preceding Friday.

The following language will be deleted from Article 9.5:

~~Holidays which fall on a Sunday shall be observed on the following non-holiday work day. Holidays which fall on a Saturday shall be observed on the preceding non-holiday work day.~~

The above changes will be noted as a sideletter and will be incorporated into the next MOU update.
