

#### Soquel Dr Buffered Bike Lane & Congestion Mitigation Project

5.6 miles from Harbor High to Aptos. Estimated construction start: Dec. 2022 - Mar. 2023

- Bikes: 10+ miles of continuous protected or buffered bike lanes
- Pedestrians: 0.6 miles of sidewalk gap closures,
  11 enhanced pedestrian crossings with Rapid
  Flashing Beacons, 94 ADA ramp upgrades
- 3. Adaptive Traffic Signals: Upgrades to 22 intersections with (ATS) and Traffic Signal Priority (TSP) for METRO

#### Highway 1 - Aux Lanes & Bus on Shoulder Project



#### Schedule

Construction starting this December, will continue into 2024.

**Figure 1** - Phase 1 Project includes auxiliary lanes and a bus on shoulder facility in both directions of Highway 1 (41<sup>st</sup> Avenue to Soquel Drive), retaining walls, soundwalls, and a new bicycle/pedestrian overcrossing at Chanticleer Avenue



#### **Soquel Dr Phase 2**

 Applying in December to extend Soquel Dr multi-modal improvements to Freedom Blvd. and implement transit improvements between La Fonda and Watsonville.

#### **CONTRACT 2 - SOQUEL DRIVE**

Provide upgrades to signals to feature adaptive signal control



Add transit priority at signals



- Install buffered and protected bike lanes
- Add sidewalk gap closures and upgrades, connections to Aptos schools



Install ADA curb ramps at intersections



Upgrade crosswalk visibility by installing rapid flashing beacons at some locations

#### **CONTRACT 3 - TRANSIT**



Add two zero-emission buses for SC Metro's Cross-County Routes



Install in-lane bus boarding platforms at 34 locations



Add bus shelters at 40 locations



Provide solar-powered real time arrival displays at 41 locations



#### Add ticket validators at 38 locations



#### Sustainability Update to the County General Plan


**Goal**: create 15 minute neighborhoods.

A 15-minute neighborhood is a neighborhood in which you can access all of your most basic, dayto-day needs within a 15minute walk of your home. It is also sometimes called a complete neighborhood.



#### **Climate Action and Adaptation Plan**


- County updating plan from 2013 with new focus on adaptation.
- New emissions inventory available. Passenger vehicles account for roughly 50%.
- Gas burning cars are making it hotter.

- Largest General Plan Amendment in 25 years
- Amendments to the County Code
- New zoning types: Residential Flex, Medical Flex
- Creation of Santa Cruz County Design Guidelines
- Specific Rezonings at Thurber Ln/Soquel Dr and on Portola Dr

Setback variation




Roofline and height changes


### **Citizens Assembly on the Housing Element**

### Heart of Soquel - Call to Artists


- Seeking an artist for a site-specific public art component to Heart of Soquel Parkway

- Deadline for submission is December 16th, 2022






### **Verizon Cell Tower Live**

#### coverage without proposed site:

- Live as of October 11th.
- County is negotiating a lease to add First Responder Equipment



#### **Benchlands Camp Cleared**

- Approximately 30% of campers accepted alternative accomodations
- Capacity remains at River St Camp and City Overlook Shelter
- Over \$2M in housing vouchers distributed
- Planning for additional shelter options underway
- Increased funding for Downtown Streets Team and cleanup


