In order for the Assessor to determine whether or not your property qualifies for this adjustment, you must complete the Application for Reassessment form. By law, the Assessor cannot process the application if it is not returned within 12 months after the occurrence of said damage. A claim can be made for damage to either real or personal property.

An application for reassessment must be made by the person who, on January 1, owned, possessed or had under their control taxable property, which was damaged, or destroyed, or by a person who acquired the property after January 1 and is liable for the property taxes for the succeeding tax year. (The succeeding tax year covers the period from July 1 through June 30).

If available, please attach copies of a contractor or insurance company's estimate to repair the damage.

The application must be executed under penalty of perjury, and if executed outside of the State of California, verified by affidavit.
