II. REVIEW OF AGENDA

Chief Giraldo provided a brief overview of the agenda.

V. REPORT AND DISCUSSION

A. Report from the Chair: AB 109 Implementation and Outcomes

- Chief Giraldo reported that the CCP was reauthorized by the Board of Supervisors and there is now Board representation with the appointment of John Leopold.

- Cassie Licker, from the Public Defenders' Office, provided an update on Prop 47 outreach.
- Chief Giraldo provided an overview of the results and recommended changes from a recent CCP membership survey.
- Chief Giraldo announced that the Probation Department is working on establishing a Day Reporting Center that will consolidate services for Probation clients.

B. Operations Work Group: Report and Discussion of Implementation Evaluation Response

- Shaina Zura, Sr. Behavioral Health Manager for HSA, provided a report back from the Operations Work Group regarding the Implementation Evaluation Response. Shaina encouraged CCP members, or their representatives, to attend the work group meetings.
- Tim Newman, Director of Operations for the Superior Court, provided an overview of the court processing recommendations.

VI. ACTION ITEMS

A. Consider Carryover Funding for Blueprint for Shared Safety Planning and Crime Survivor Outreach

Chief Giraldo gave a brief overview of the history of Blueprint for Shared Safety work on Santa Cruz County. Marisa Arrona and Elizabeth Siggins, from Californians for Safety and Justice (CSJ), gave an overview of the work CSJ has completed with other jurisdictions and the five principles for Shared Safety. Sarah Emmert, Director of Community Organizing for United Way of Santa Cruz County, identified crime survivors as being central to the Blueprint implementation and planning process. There was discussion regarding how a crime “survivor” is defined and methods for serving people with mental illness.

Giang Nguyen made a motion to approve 2017-18 carryover funding for Blueprint for Shared Safety planning and crime survivor outreach.
