PROPOSED MEDICAL OFFICE BUILDING (KAISER) PROJECT


- 4 story building with approximately 160,000 square feet of medical office use for specialty outpatient services, including advanced medical and urgent care clinics and outpatient surgery facilities.
- Open to the public from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.; expected number of on-site staff, at peak, would be approximately 300 persons.
- 4 story parking garage, with bike lockers, 730 parking spaces and approximately 47 charging stations for electric vehicles, and bike lockers.

WHAT TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENTS IS THE PROJECT PROPOSING?

- Traffic light at primary entrance from Soquel Avenue
- Left hand center turn lane extended from Paul Minnie to Rodeo Gulch crossing, just east of Mattison Ln.
- Frontage Improvements:
- New curb, gutter, and sidewalk, extending
 from 270' west of the project site to just east of Mattison Ln.
- Class II bicycle lane striping, from Soquel drive to just east of Mattison Ln.
- Gross Rd. and 41st Ave. intersection improvements
 - Diverter
 - Signage and striping improvements








