41 VETERANS HOUSING AND HOMELESS PREVENTION BOND ACT OF 2014. Authorizes \$600 million in general obligation bonds for affordable multifamily supportive housing to relieve homelessness, affordable transitional housing, affordable rental housing, or related facilities for veterans and their families.
