



Factors for Increase in 17/18 Property Tax Bills

Increase in Tax Rates - New School Bonds

- 1. Santa Cruz High School District Bond Measure A 2016 Series A**
Passed November 8, 2016 with an 75.80% Yes Vote
Estimate at time of election \$29.50 per \$100,000 of assessed valuation.
- 2. Santa Cruz Elementary School District Bond Measure B 2016 Series A**
Passed November 8, 2016 with an 79.50% Yes Vote
Estimate at time of election \$29.50 per \$100,000 of assessed valuation.
- 3. Soquel Elementary School District Bond Measure C Debt Service 2017 Series A**
Passed November 8, 2016 with an 71.56% Yes Vote
Estimate at time of issue \$30.00 per \$100,000 of assessed valuation.
- 4. Scotts Valley Unified School District Bond 2014 Series B**
Passed June 3, 2014 with a 72.17 % Yes Vote Series B added 2017
Estimate at time of issue \$51.50 per \$100,000 of assessed valuation.

Increases in Special Assessment Charges

- 1. Branciforte Fire**
Charges for Branciforte Fire doubled from last year. Most significant is the residential which went from \$60 to \$120. Voted in on August 30, 2016 Special Election with an 89.04 % Yes Vote.
- 2. Zayante Fire District Parcel Tax**
Increase per parcel charge from \$35 to \$68. Voted in on November 8, 2016 with an 80.13% Yes Vote.
- 3. Boulder Creek Fire District Parcel Tax**
Brand new charge of \$35 per parcel. Voted in on November 8, 2016 with an 83.84% Yes Vote.
- 4. Lakeside School District Parcel Tax**
Increase per parcel charge from \$311 to \$647. Voted in on March 7, 2017 Special Election with a 70.31% Yes Vote.
