DEBRIS FLOW TOWN HALL EVENT

Santa Cruz County is pleased to offer a COVID-19-safe town hall meeting for residents who have questions about the potential for winter debris flow events.

In rainy seasons following severe fires, the risks from flooding, mudflows and debris flows are significantly elevated, posing a threat to life and property. County emergency staff have assessed the risk to residents and provided a debris flow evacuation map at community.zonehaven.com.
