Please note: All mitigation recommendations contained in the technical reports must be implemented prior to issuance of temporary geologic hazard clearance; implementation may require separate building permit approvals.

- Geologic report required:** Submit a geologic report prepared by a professional geologist that provides recommendations to mitigate identified geologic hazards affecting the temporary housing site to an “ordinary” level of risk.
- Hydrologic report required:** Submit a hydrologic report prepared by a registered civil engineer that provides a 100-year base flood elevation (BFE) for the parcel, along with a surveyed topographic map showing the areas inundated by the 100-year base flood in relation to the temporary housing site.
