INDIVIDUAL ASSISTANCE DEADLINE EXTENDED

The Santa Cruz County Office of Response, Recovery and Resilience is pleased to announce FEMA has granted a request to extend the deadline to apply for individual assistance due to the February/March storms for 60 days.

The new deadline is July 20th, 2023. A Disaster Recovery Center remains open at the County Governmental Building, 701 Ocean St., Santa Cruz. In-person assistance is available Monday through Friday, 9 a.m.-5 p.m.
