Santa Cruz County Animal Shelter wants to encourage families to consider adopting a new furry friend this holiday season! Whether you're a local and not traveling, or even if you're just visiting us here in the Santa Cruz area over the holiday, we have a wonderful assortment of pets available to make your family and home complete.

Because we have so many pets right now, we're offering ½ price adoption fees on most pets, and any dog or cat over 6 years of age has no fee (a \$29 license fee is required for dogs).

The adoption fee for puppies under 6 months old will be just \$105 and adult dogs \$75. Kittens are \$60, adult cats \$50. Rabbits are \$35, and pets over 6 years of age have no fees. The reduced adoption fees still include vaccinations, spay or neuter surgery, and a microchip to help protect the pet and get families off on the right paw for a long, healthy life together!

A long holiday weekend can be a great time to bring a pet home, since you may have a little more time to spend helping the pet adapt and get comfortable with new people, routines, and environments.

"Thanksgiving hasn't happened yet, but our shelter is already STUFFED... with wonderful, but homeless pets," said Jillian Ganley, Shelter Supervisor. "We're hoping folks will take advantage of this opportunity to get 100% of the fun and snuggles at just 50% of the cost!"
